#### Introduction



### 1. Registration

All E-Poster presenters must register and pay the applicable registration fees to remain the program. Presenters who fail to pay register fees risk being removed from the program at the discretion of the Program Committee. There is no reduced registration fee for presenters. Please be reminded that the early bird registration deadline has been extended to **June 30, 2026, at 23:59 (GMT+8)**. You will receive a QR code for badge pick-up around one month before the Congress.


## 2. Preparing Your E-Poster

All posters should be a visual presentation of your submitted abstract.

### APVRS 2026 E-POSTER TEMPLATE

**\*Please note that the sizes of the E-Poster and Physical Poster are different. Make sure to download the correct one.**

While the template is **not mandatory**, you may use it directly, edit it to suit your own style, or design your own, ensuring the APVRS 2026 banner is placed at the top.

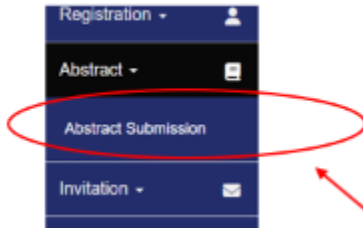
- **Format: JPEG/JPG**  
-If you edited with the template, please make sure you convert your poster into a **JPG file** from the sample e-poster **pptx file**
- **E-Poster Size: 1080 (W) x 1920 (H) Pixels (9:16 aspect ratio, portrait)**  
**\*Please be careful that the size is different from the physical poster**
- **Design:** It is mandatory to insert our **APVRS 2026 Congress banner** on **top** of the e-poster. Font size is specified in the sample e-poster. Choose Arial or another font that can be read clearly at a distance. Put **light colored fonts on dark backgrounds** and **dark fonts on light-colored backgrounds** so that viewers can see the text clearly. Remember, overcrowding a poster slide makes it difficult to read. Help your readers by providing clear labels or headings for each section of your presentation. **The Primary Author may choose to include his/her photo at the designated area of the poster (beside poster title).**
- **References:** Please include **eight pertinent references at most.**
- **Tables:** Table should be simple and easy to follow. **Minimum font size** for data in tables is **10 points**. **All graphs and tables** must be embedded in your file. The **legend** of a figure should appear below the figure.
- **Do not** insert or embed **any videos** in your presentation.
- **Financial Disclosures:** Financial interest(s), if any, **MUST be disclosed and included** in the poster. Presentations made at the Congress **must not be used to promote a commercial product.**
- Please ensure that **you have permission** to use any images you include in the e-poster. This includes a **license for copyrighted materials and consent forms from patients** who are recognizable in photographs or images.

### 3. E-Poster Presentation

- No oral presentation will be required.
- The presenters can prepare an audio recording (if any, **maximum length: 3 minutes, MP3**) to accompany their poster presentations. The recording should be uploaded to the APVRS Congress system at <http://congress.2026.apvrs.org> by
- A QR code, which will be displayed on each poster, can be downloaded from the Congress system. After you have uploaded the audio annotation to the congress system, you may download the QR code and insert it into your e-poster file. When the QR code is scanned, viewers will be directed to a link where they can hear the recording prepared by the poster presenter.
- **E-Poster Upload Deadline:** Speakers must register and upload their E-Poster (with audio recording(s), if any) to the Congress system no later than **July 24, 2026 (Fri) at 23:59 (GMT+8)**. Kindly note that all speakers **must** complete the registration process for abstract presentation submissions.
- File uploaded after the deadline may **NOT** be able to be incorporated into the program. Before submitting, please make sure your e-poster can be viewed without any failure.
- Resubmission requests after the said deadline may **not** be considered. When you are ready to submit.

### 4. Submission Guidelines

- you may upload your e-poster by clicking “**Upload**” under [Abstract] → [Abstract Submission]. The E-Poster PDF and audio presentation may be uploaded by either the **submitter or the presenter**.






