Introduction



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1. Registration

All Physical Poster presenters must register and pay the applicable registration fees to remain in the program. Presenters who fail to pay registration fees risk being removed from the program at the discretion of the Program Committee. There is no reduced registration fee for presenters. Please go to the Registration Page on the Congress website at <https://congress.2026.apvrs.org/>. Please be reminded that the early bird registration deadline has been extended to **June 30, 2026, at 23:59 (GMT+8)**. You will receive a QR code for badge pick-up around one month before the Congress.

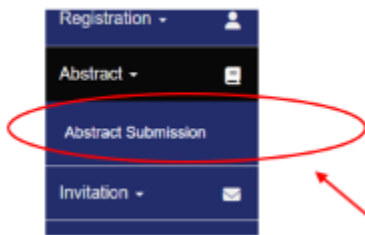

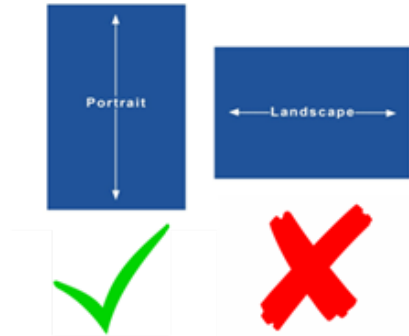


3. Poster Guidelines

- The poster should be designed to be mounted on a poster board in portrait orientation by using the provided Velcro to attach it. Helper will be available to give the Verlco.
- **Poster Size:** A0 Size, 841 (W) mm x 1189 (H) mm in portrait

- **Poster Number:** The poster number will be placed in the **top corner** of the board by the Congress Secretariat. **Please make sure you mount your poster on the board with the number assigned to you.**

Poster number will be available in your abstract portal by the end of July.

- **Poster Mounting:** Please use the **Velcro** provided by the Congress Secretariat for mounting your poster onto the poster board.
- **Poster Layout:** The poster should include **Poster Title**, **Abstract Code** and **Authors**. The content should be clearly structured under the headings of **Purpose**, **Methods**, **Results**, and **Conclusions**. Heading fonts should be **larger** than body text. Make sure that the poster is not too crowded and has enough blank space.
- **References:** Please include **eight (8) pertinent references at most**.
- **Poster Design:** Please insert our congress banner on top of the poster (**link for banner attached in poster guideline section**). Posters can be designed using PowerPoint, Corel Draw, or Adobe InDesign. White text on a dark background may be used, but only sparingly. In general, white, muted, or pastel backgrounds with black text are the best options. Use an appropriate balance of text and images to convey your message in an easy-to-read way. **The Primary Author may choose to include his/her photo at designated area of the poster (beside poster title).**

Poster Template: A template is available on our Congress website:

<https://2026.apvrs.org/guidelines-for-presenters/> . While the template is **not mandatory**, you may use it directly, edit it to suit your own style, or design your own, ensuring the APVRS 2026 banner is placed at the top. ***Please note that the sizes of the Physical Poster and the E-Poster are different. Make sure to download the correct one.**

- **Text & Font Size:** The text should be concise and ensure good visibility at **approximately 3 feet**. Include all the most important ideas, but not necessarily all finer details. The **minimum font size for body text: 20 points**. Text should be **single-spaced**. **Do not use ALL UPPER CASE TEXT**, as it is difficult to read.
- **Tables:** Tables should be simple and easy to follow.
- **Illustrations:** The legend of a figure should appear below the figure. Illustrations are more appealing if they are in color.

- **Permission for Images:** Please ensure that you have **permission** to use any images you include in the poster. This includes a **license for copyrighted materials and consent forms from patients** who are recognizable in photographs or images.
- **Financial Interest:** Financial interests, if any, **MUST** be disclosed and included in the poster. Presentations made at the Congress **must not be used to promote a commercial product**.
